We put together and created colorful caterpillars! ! The kids were given a small amount of colorful cotton balls to match to each color.

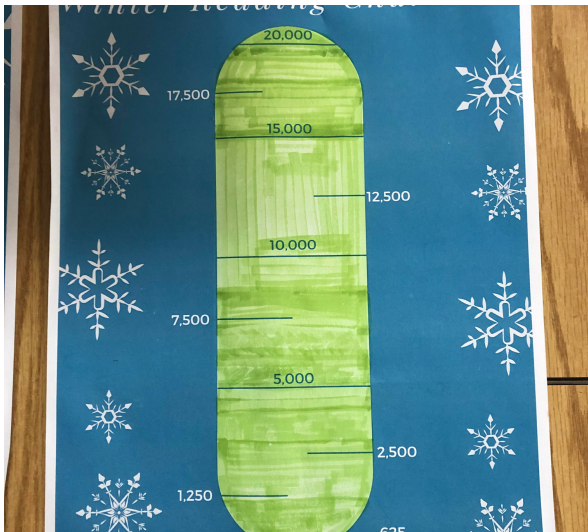

Bookclub Reads

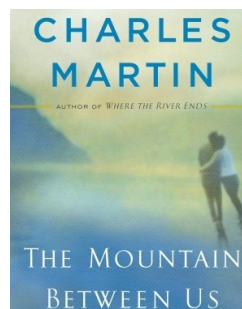
The Newell Public Library has two active book clubs. These are what they are reading this month!
