Cricut Policy for Patron Use

The library has a Cricut Explore Air for use by the public.

Cricut is an electronic cutting machine for DIY projects and crafts. Designs created on the computer can be cut or drawn into material such as paper, cardstock, vinyl, fabric, and more. Our Cricut cutter uses files from Cricut's Design Space website or you can create your own.

There is no cost to use the Cricut Cutting machines; however, you must provide your own supplies.

Use of the Cricut is at the discretion of library staff. The library reserves the right to deny use of the equipment. Misuse of the Cricut or tools will result in not being able to use the machine.

It is expressly prohibited to print/cut any object that violates or infringes upon a patent, trademark, or other proprietary right.
