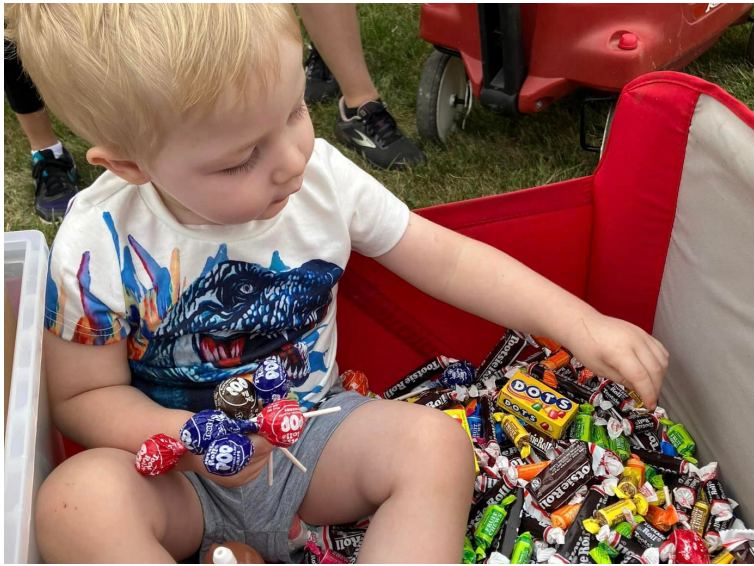
## Summer Reading Program Party!

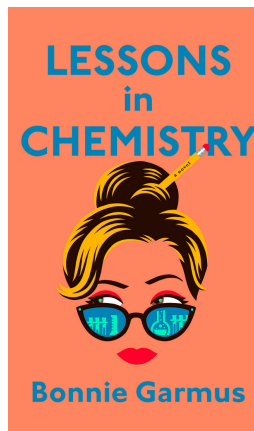

The Newell Public Library has three active book clubs. These are what they are reading this month!

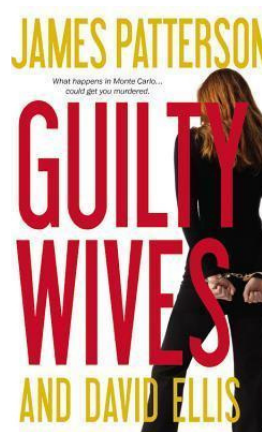


### Book Club #1 Books for August
